Three Steps That Could Save Your Life

1. Call 811 before you dig

811 is the national phone number that initiates the process of locating and marking the underground utility lines in your yard or at your job. Call 811 at least three business days before you dig.

2. Wait the required time for facilities to be marked

One Call Center personnel will notify Central Wisconsin Electric Cooperative to mark the approximate locations of buried gas or electric lines with high-visibility safety paint and/or flags. There is no charge for this locating service.

3. Respect the marks or flags and dig with care

When you start digging, stay at least 24 inches away from the marked lines.

Hand digging with extreme caution is required when digging within the 24-inch tolerance zone.
