Are you finding holiday lights that don't work?



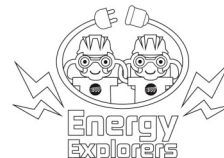
We'll recycle them for free. There is a drop box available in our lobby! Our hours are Monday-Friday, 7:30 a.m.-4 p.m.
