Shedding Light on Tigerton Streets

A recently completed street light project in Tigerton is a great example. Linemen Quinn Zdroik and Chris Tuszke replaced eight 150 watt high pressure sodium street lights with more energy efficient 70 watt LEDs. "We were very surprised at how affordable the lights were and we hope they operate as planned. If they perform as we expect, we will install more in the future."said Mike Wade, CWEC President & CEO. There are many benefits to switching from traditional street lighting to LED street lighting. Chief among the benefits is that LEDs have extremely long lives, resulting in lower maintenance. LEDs are highly energy efficient using less electricity while producing more light per watt. Because of their energy efficiency and long lifespan, LEDs are environmentally friendly.
