CWEC Scholarship Guidelines

- 1. Scholarships will be available to college, vocational, or technical school bound students through the CWEC Operation Roundup program.
- 2. Both traditional and nontraditional students are encouraged to apply.
- 3. To be eligible, either the student or parents must have their primary residence located on CWEC lines and participate in Operation Roundup.
- 4. Scholarship winners must maintain a minimum 2.0 grade point average and full-time student equivalent (12+ earned credits) during their first quarter or semester of their fall 2020 college or vocational-technical school year.
- 5. Payment will be made upon completion of the first quarter or semester of their fall 2020 college, vocational, or technical school year. Each recipient will need to provide the cooperative with a copy of his or her grades and proof of enrollment for second semester.
- 6. If you do not meet the requirements, you can reapply the next year.

Please mail your fall 2020 grades and proof of enrollment for second semester, or drop it off in person at the CWEC office in Rosholt.
